
### Case 2: a lip lesion


- 17-year-old female referred to your clinic with a history of multiple craniofacial venous malformations.











# Should this patient receive periprocedural anticoagulation?








Ultrasound used to guide needle into the venous lakes of the venous malformation.






#### Digital Subtraction Angiogram of venous malformation
