Hypertrophic pubic bone

- 4. I don't know




What would you do first?

- Caryotype 46 XX
- Sacral ratio 0.56

- Diverted descending colostomy was made
- Distal colostogram, cystogram, and vaginostogram were performed





What would be your surgical approach?


- 1. Laparotomy + posterior sagittal transanorectal approach + urogenital sinus mobilization
- 2. Posterior sagittal approach + rectal and urogenital sinus mobilization
- 3. Vaginal replacement + vesicostomy






